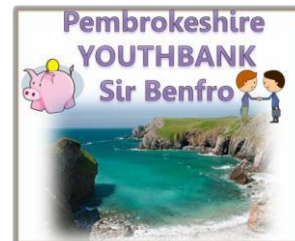

Grant Application Guidelines 2019/20

Who is Pembrokeshire Youth Bank?

We're a group of young people from Pembrokeshire who give out grants of up to £500 to young people with good ideas for projects that will benefit their community.

Checklist – do you have what we want?

- ⚙ Are you a young person aged 11-25 or in a group where at least 50% are young people?
- ⚙ Do you live in Pembrokeshire?
- ⚙ Is there an adult linked to you or your group (aged over 18 years old)?
- ⚙ Does your project help the community and those involved?
- ⚙ Will you be able to provide evidence of the completed project (i.e. accept a visit from Youth Bank, take photos or videos, give a written details of the project)?
- ⚙ Are you willing to promote Pembrokeshire Youth Bank?
- ⚙ Can a young person complete the forms or make a video application and complete the Equal Opportunities Monitoring Form? (Adult support is accepted.)

If you can tick all these boxes, move on to the Applying to Youth Bank section!

N.B. Pembrokeshire Youth Bank is unable to fund religious / political projects, anything illegal

or discriminatory, or anything that would give us a bad reputation.



Applying to YouthBank

Completing the application form

- Get your hands on a form:
 - Call 01437 775744
 - Rose.davis@pembrokeshire.gov.uk
- Application forms must be completed by a young person or they will not be considered.
- If you need help, call the number at the top of the page.
- Make sure you have provided evidence of your budget.
- Complete Equal Opportunities Monitoring Form.
- Return to the address at the top of the page.

Applying by video / audio

- Get a form to see what we need
 - Call 01437 775744
 - Rose.davis@pembrokeshire.gov.uk
- Look at the questions and film answers:
 - You can film the site of the project
 - Interview group members or people who will benefit from the project
 - Film the stuff you need in the shop and their prices
 - Make sure you have provided evidence of your budget
- We still need you to fill out the monitoring form
- Send your video to the address above

If you're successful

You will receive a letter informing you of this and a cheque in the post.

If you're unsuccessful

You will receive a letter within 2 weeks of the deadline explaining why.
